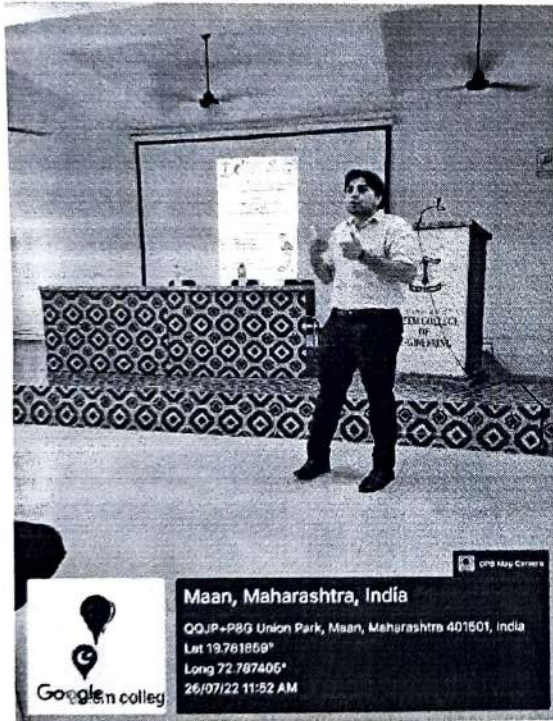


Day-2



He mentioned entrepreneurship is thought to be a key driver of economic growth. While there are myriad forms of entrepreneurship, ranging from self-employment to small and medium size enterprises to technology- and innovation-driven startups, recent research provides evidence that the relationship between entrepreneurship and economic growth is driven not by overall quantity of new firm entry, but rather by a small subset of high-growth startups that are primarily categorized as innovation-driven. He defined Innovation Driven Entrepreneurship (IDE) as the pursuit of opportunities focused on products or repeatable services beyond the local market. Making a bold statement Mr. Santosh D. Khawale said we need more than just more start-ups who create low paying jobs. We need businesses that brings innovations to market that deliver such high value that customers are willing to pay a margin premium. This is what he was calling innovation driven entrepreneurship or innovation driven start-ups. These start-ups don't have to follow in the model of Silicon Valley and be focused on technology. Innovations can cover a wide range of areas. He gave example of innovating education and how students can be prepared with STEM skills that will prepare them to compete in the emerging creative economy.

The session continued till 4:30 pm. At the last students and faculty members were given opportunity to ask any query or doubt regarding the session if they had. Many students took the advantage of this session and solved their respective doubts with the speaker.

At valedictory **Prof. Wasim** gave vote of thanks to speaker and concluded the session.

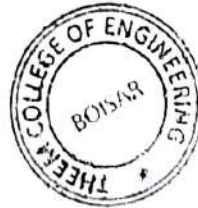



A Report on “Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)”

Objectives:

1. The main objective of this webinar was to discuss –Generating Ideas, capturing ideas, beginning innovation, developing a business- effectiveness strategy, Applying Business Improvement, and Decline.
2. To inculcate creativity and innovativeness in our students.

Outcomes:

1. Students were able to understand importance of “Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)”, and its advantages.
2. Students were able to understand the importance of technology assessment.

A webinar on “Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)” was held on 3rd March 2022. Mr. Yogesh Karunakar, Head EDC, IIR Labs K. C. College of Engineering was the guest speaker.

In his address Mr. Yogesh Karunakar explained the process of the innovation development and its stages. Citing an example of final year project and keeping users in mind at every stage of process. Mr. Yogesh Karunakar, elaborated the process of technology readiness and commercialisation of the technology. Technology Readiness Levels (TRLs) are a method for understanding the technical maturity of a technology during its acquisition phase. TRLs allow engineers to have a consistent datum of reference for understanding technology evolution, regardless of their technical background.

Further, Mr. Yogesh Karunakar explained how the technology transfer from innovator to industry takes place.

The session focussed on the innovation development and understanding technology readiness level, manufacturing readiness level and investment readiness level. A technology assessment is needed to determine the technology is ready or not to be commercialized. An approach has been used to assess the readiness of technology, namely Technology Readiness Level (TRL) adopted from NASA.
