
Day-1

Session 1: Webinar on Entrepreneurial Project Development by Prof.K.T.V. Talele.







Day-2







Session 2: Webinar on "Innovation Driven Entrepreneurship" by Mr. Santosh Khawale.


Mr. Santosh D. Khawale, the speaker gave a wonderful session where he shared what entrepreneurship is and how innovation can play a magical role in entrepreneurship. He mentioned entrepreneurship is thought to be a key driver of economic growth. While there are myriad forms of entrepreneurship, ranging from self-employment to small and medium size enterprises to technology- and innovation-driven startups, recent research provides evidence that the relationship between entrepreneurship and economic growth is driven not by overall quantity of new firm entry, but rather by a small subset of high growth startups that are primarily categorized as innovation-driven. He defined Innovation Driven Entrepreneurship (IDE) as the pursuit of opportunities focused on products or repeatable services beyond the local market. Making a bold statement Mr. Santosh D. Khawale said we need more than just more start-ups who create low paying jobs. We need businesses that brings innovations to market that deliver such high value that customers are willing to pay a margin premium. This is what he was calling innovation driven entrepreneurship or innovation driven start-ups. These start-ups don't have to follow in the model of Silicon Valley and be focused on technology. Innovations can cover a wide range of areas. He gave example of innovating education and how students can be prepared with STEM skills that will prepare them to compete in the emerging creative economy.



A Report on "Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)"

Objectives:

- The main objective of this webinar was to discuss –Generating Ideas, capturing ideas, beginning innovation, developing a business-effectiveness strategy, Applying Business Improvement, and Decline.
- 2. To inculcate creativity and innovativeness in our students.

- Students were able to understand importance of "Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)", and its advantages.
- 2. Students were able to understand the importance of technology assessment.

A webinar on "Process of Innovation Development & Technology Readiness Level (TRL)" was held on 3rd March 2022. Mr. Yogesh Karunakar, Head EDC, IIAR Labs K. C. College of Engineering was the guest speaker.

In his address Mr. Yogesh Karunakar explained the process of the innovation development and its stages. Citing an example of final year project and keeping users in mind at every stage of process.
